It's easy to apply to Queen's! The full application process is available online at queensu.ca/admission/about-applying. Once a Student ID has been generated, the student is guided through the steps online and by email. All candidates for admission into the B.Mus. program (including concurrent B.Mus./B.Ed. applicants) will be invited to come to Queen's for an audition and interview, at which time they will have an opportunity to meet faculty and students, and to ask questions about the program.
