To apply for admission, students must submit a completed, signed application form, a \$500 CAD non refundable application fee, a photocopy of government issued photo I.D. or passport, a resume/CV (no culinary experience required), proof of English proficiency (if applicable), a passport size photo, a letter of motivation, an official Transcript showing completion of an Ontario Secondary School Diploma, or equivalent, or a passing grade on the Wonderlic test.
