Sweden has more than 35 universities offering almost 1000 full-degree programmes taught entirely in English. Find your programme at <https://studyinsweden.se>. You apply through <https://universityadmissions.se>, Sweden's central application portal. With one application, you can apply for up to 8 bachelor's or 4 master's programmes at different universities around Sweden. The application deadline is 15 January 2020.

If you are not a citizen of the EU, EEA or Switzerland, you will need to pay an application fee of around USD 125 along with your application.
